Hello Kansas State Fair 4-H Communications Participants:

We are excited that you will be taking part in the Kansas State Fair. You will find your presentations on the schedule. We tried to honor all requests, but had to move a few things here and there, so please double-check.

When you get to 4-H Centennial Hall. Please check in at the Information counter at the east end of the building, where you will get a scorecard to take to your stage.

It is helpful if you arrive 15 minutes early to get checked in and ready to speak.

Each stage will be equipped with two tables, two easels, two microphones, a projector, a screen, and one 110-volt electrical power strip. 4-H members are encouraged to use technology when it enhances the presentation. Presenters should bring a computer that will work with an HDMI cord. PRESENTERS NEED TO HAVE THE PRESENTATION ON A FLASH DRIVE OR SAVED ON THEIR COMPUTER. DO NOT RELY ON A WEB-BASED PLATFORM. Internet access at the fairgrounds is not great!

No range, microwave or refrigerator is available in the demonstration areas. If extension cords are needed beyond the provided power strip, participants need to bring them.

We will try to stay on time as much as possible. If you will not be able to participate, please let us know, as there are a few on the schedule who would like a different day if possible, but all slots on the schedule are currently full. Once we get to the fair, there is usually some flexibility as cancellations happen.
